- Social Services – Joyce Dolcourt gave a brief update on Social Service Appropriation committee meetings, she has been attending. They are also scheduled to the 8am-9:50am time slot, four days each week, they have not been starting on time but they do end on time because of floor time beginning at 10am each morning.
